## **Forestry Valuation and Policy Relevance**

held on December 14, 2007

in the Small Board Room, Carolinum, Charles University, Ovocný trh 5, Prague 1

The seminar will focus on the use of non-market valuation methods and their policy relevance in the field of forestry. The results of the current work on valuation of recreation functions of forests will be presented. A particular emphasis will be given to a discussion of travel cost method, choice experiment and contingent valuation method. Further, the role and policy implication of this type of research for decision-making process will be discussed.

The workshop is addressed especially to post-graduate students, young scientists and senior scholars in the environmental economics, and policy makers in the field of forestry. The presented papers will be published in the book of seminar proceedings. The presentations and discussion will be held in English.
